



# CDL-B Truck Driver Training

## Commercial Truck Drivers License Class B (CDL-B)

This course prepares individuals to apply technical knowledge and skills to drive trucks, delivery vehicles, for-hire vehicles and other commercial vehicles with air brakes. Students will prepare to pass the Indiana control-skills driving test to obtain their commercial driver's license class B. To get a CDL you must be a United States citizen or lawful permanent resident, and be at least 18 years old if you will be transporting property within state lines or at least 21 years old if you will be transporting people. You must have held a valid driver's license for at least one year.

To enroll in the course individuals need a valid drivers license and social security card. To achieve certification the individual will also need to pass a DOT physical examination and pass a NIDA, 5-panel drug screen.
